
## **VEHICLE PARTICULARS & WARRANTY**

A motor vehicle is covered by the terms of a statutory warranty under the Motor Vehicles Dealers Act 1973 because the cash price (inc. GST) paid is \$4000 or more and the vehicle is not more than 12 years old and has travelled not more than 180 000 km. The length of time the vehicle is covered under warranty is determined by the age of the vehicle and kilometers it has travelled at the time of sale. Where a vehicle is -

- \* not more than 10 years old and has travelled not more than 150 000 km at the time of sale warranty is for 3 months or 5000km, whichever happens
- \* between 10 and 12 years old or has travelled between 150 000 and 180 000 km at the time of sale warranty is for 1 month or 1500 km, whichever happens first.

A motorcycle is covered by the terms of a statutory warranty because the cash price (inc GST) paid is \$3500 or more and the motorcycle is not more than 80 000 km. The warranty is for 3 months or 5000 km, whichever happens first.

The warranty means that the selling dealer must repair or make good all defects which make or are likely to make the vehicle unroadworthy or unserviceable. The repair should make the vehicle roadworthy and in a reasonable condition having regard to its age.
